# **DISTRICT UPDATES:**

Mr. Steve Stein reported to the Board and the Administration that he has talked to Mr. Neil Pellmann, Professional Engineer, of the Will/South Cook, Soil and Water Conservation District, regarding our assessment for the "U" water issues at Peotone Junior High School. Mr. Pellmann stated that the assessment is not ready yet, but should be completed sometime next week.
