FOR DISCUSSION:

Mr. Trevor Moore, Chief Business School Officer, presented to the Board and Administration, his presentation on the District's Tax Levy. Mr. Moore highlighted in his presentation the key points for the 2018 Tax Levy which are listed below:

- The District's operating levy, which includes all funds except Debt Service is being requested to be set at \$11,819, 418 (2.89% over last year's request or 4.90% over last year's actual extension).
- The Debt Service tax extension will increase by \$1,356 to \$5,020,016 or 0.03%.
- Total Levy Request for 2018 id \$16,839,343. We will not receive that much new revenue, but are requesting more due to our Equalized Assessed Value (EAV) and new property being unknown at this time.
- Our best guess as to what we will actually receive, due to being limited to a Consumer Price Index (CPI) increase of 2.1% is \$11,523,418 or \$256,618 in new operating revenue, which equates to 2.28% increase in operating revenue.

ADMINISTRATION REPORTS:

Dr. Charles Vitton, Assistant Superintendent, reported to the Board that On the evening of November 7th we hosted presentations by Tim Guerin, Principal of KACC and Dan McLaughlin, Executive Director of the Chicagoland Associated General Contractors to discuss opportunities for students during and after high school in regard to careers in trade fields and the construction industry.

The Peotone Educational Foundation recently awarded teacher grant requests in the amount of \$4,379.72. The PEF is pleased to be able to offer our teaching staff resources that support learning in the classroom.

Mr. Chris Gibson, Assistant Principal PJHS/Athletic Director PHS, reported to the Board that our fall seasons have ended. Our soccer team advanced to the Super-Sectional. We had one cross-country runner advance to the State Meet. Our Fall Sports Awards Night was held on November 5, 2018. We had mixed reviews for the format that was used. Our Winter Sports are underway. The girls' basketball team participated in the Beecher Lady cat Classic and the JV team took third at the Seneca JV Invitational. The boys' basketball teams are participating at the Manteno/Coal City Turkey Tournament the week of Thanksgiving. Our Wrestling program opened on Tuesday, November 20, 2018 at home against Grant Park. Bowling is slated to begin on December 1st.

Mr. Scott Wenzel, Principal of Peotone Junior High School, was absent for the November Regular Board meeting.

Mr. Trevor Moore, Chief School Business Official, Mr. Moore started by providing an overview of the fiscal year 2018 audit results. The district's auditor will be at the meeting in December to provide a more detailed presentation to the board. There were very few audit adjustments that needed to be made, with the only notable one being one cash adjustment of approximately \$65,000. Total direct receipts were \$22,211,864. Total direct expenditures were \$22,552,974. These figures produce an operational deficit of (\$341,110), however, once the land sale is included, the overall fund balance increased by \$320,022. Mr. Moore and the auditors did find a few technical mistakes in the FY19 budget, so I do plan to amend it in the spring. The district has started using a third party administrator for the 403(b) plan named US OMNI. This gives employees a way to make changes electronically and have more current information about plan. It also allows payroll to make just one payment each pay period instead of multiple to each provider. There are other benefits provided like some legal counsel and prepared plan documents. The district sold the working cash bonds last Tuesday, November 13. Things went considerably better than PMA expected. The new working cash bonds were sold on the open market. The refunding bonds were sold to the Worth Township Treasurer. The reason for selling them directly was because the district got a lower interest rate than what was available on the open market. In total, the district was able to save about \$77,000 compared to what was being estimated leading up to the sale. This savings was In part due to a credit rating upgrade. The district went from A1 to Aa3 which is the fourth best possible. It is very unusual to see a government entity receive a rating upgrade right now according to PMA.

The business office is preparing an application for a Property Tax Relief Grant through the State of Illinois. While this would help offset local property taxes, it is unlikely Peotone will receive any relief from the State because they are prioritizing districts with high tax rates and very low property wealth.

Mr. Moore reported that he has been looking into some legal options surrounding our DSEB limit and being able to reduce it if there is a successful referendum to increase our operating limiting tax rate. Discussions have been preliminary, but the district is committed to exploring every opportunity to meet the needs of the district and the community.

Mr. Craig Fantin, Principal of Peotone High School, reported to the Board that on November 10th and 11th, Stephanie Blamble and Chelsea McKay took six students to the Special Olympics Youth Activation Summit in Normal, IL. The students were Molly Marchionda, Bethany Goss, Micheal Flanagan, Jared Love, Lexi Hillman and Maggie Kuypers. At the two day conference, the students all attended seminars to work on team building and advocacy. They came up with spirt weeks, assembly ideas, and fundraiser ideas to promote their clubs. The teachers attended seminars that worked on building their Unified programs, how to fundraise successfully for your school, how to throw a successful Respect week campaign, and so much more. As a school, they set goals for our school and are excited to work on achieving these goals as a Unified Sports Program. The teachers and students both gained a lot of information from this seminar and cannot wait to build up the Unified Sports Program at Peotone High School and hopefully work on spreading it to Peotone Junior High School.

For Veterans' Day we honored our veterans and our first responders with a ceremony in the gymnasium for the entire school. Veteran Alan Blogg, Police Chief Bill Mort, and Fire Chief Bill Schreiber, each had an opportunity to speak to our students. After the ceremony we had a nurse practitioner speak to our students about the dangers of vaping.

Mrs. Suarez entered Jessica Scroppo, a Spanish IV student, into an annual poster contest for the local chapter of the American Association of Teachers of Spanish and Portuguese. Jessica's posted was of the two posters recognized as outstanding and she won \$50. I do not have the poster to display tonight because it is being used to create posters and postcards to provide to other schools to encourage the study of world languages.

Mr. Dave Weissbohn, Director of Technology, presented to the Board an outline of three different options for maintaining basic phone operations during a power outage.

- Option 1 is a Landline are difficult to get and may not be available to all
 of the buildings; service providers prefer to offer internet-based phone
 service and the phone could not be taken or moved in case of
 emergency;
- Option 2 is Cell Phones potential for phones to be misplaced or unplugged; could be taken or moved in case of emergency;
- Option 3 is Cellular, Analog Phone Devices small cellular devices that connect to a standard phone; battery backup for a few hours; could be taken or moved in case of emergency; less likely to be moved or misplaces; durable and lowest overall cost.

Mr. Weissbohn recommends the best option for the District would be Option 3. Mr. Weissbohn also stated that the switch from Comcast to AT&T for our data and internet services will be a savings of \$18,000 for the District.

Mrs. Kathy Davis, Principal of Peotone Elementary, reported to the Board that we had our Veterans Day Assembly a week ago today. We had several veterans present and they did a flag presentation. Each of the classes sang as well as a couple of songs by the entire school. Along with the assembly we do a collection for a veteran's organization. This year we did another Coins to Change Lives Challenge. We raised money for an organization called Partners Canine Education out of southern Illinois. They train therapy service dogs for Veterans at no charge. They try to use shelter dogs if at all possible. They will also train the Veteran's dog if they have the markers that a therapy dog must possess. The children and staff raised almost \$2,500.00.

This year the school will be hosting our Santa's Secret Shop instead of the PTO for our students. It will take place the Tuesday and Thursday after we return from Thanksgiving Break. This is always a fun time for our students as they get to shop for their family members.

Mrs. Amy Loy, Director of Special Services, reported to the Board, an update on our transition activities that we are working on with Mrs. Judy Karas, Transition Coordinator for the District. We are working to schedule a Peotone tour date for students and families interested in learning more about earning employability certificates through Joliet Junior College. This would also include a tour of the facility and meeting with Chef Ferrara. Also, Mrs. Karas is working to host the annual Connect to Your Future presentation at Peotone High School for junior and senior students with an IEP and their parents in February. At the Jr. High, Ms. MacDougall and her SI students completed a class project in conjunction with Veterans Day. They held a donation drive for the Prince Home in Manteno, IL. The Prince Home is co-located with the Manteno Veterans Home. This program provides housing and supportive services for Illinois Veterans who are now homeless or disabled. Finally, Mrs. Loy is working on solidifying coverage for OT needs while Mrs. Coffman has her maternity leave. I will provide detailed information at our December meeting for your approval.

Mrs. Joanne Obszanski, Principal of Peotone Intermediate Center, was absent for the November Regular Board meeting.

Mrs. Wendy Bean, Assistant Principal, reported to the Board, that we just enjoyed a very successful play weekend of "The Hobbit." Big thanks and Congratulations to Ms. Tapak, Mr. Nealon, and all of the cast and crew for all of their hard work.

Our PHS Winter Concert will be on Tuesday, December 18th at 6:00pm. This is a time change from 7:00pm because of a conflict with a basketball game.

As of this week, all winter sports have started competitions. We look forward to successful seasons from boys' and girls' basketball, wrestling, bowling, as well as cheer and dance.

Final exams will be here before we know it. Finals will be December 19th, 20th, and 21st. The full schedule with all the details is posted on our website

Mrs. Terry Wuske, Director of Food Services, had nothing to report.

Mr. Dave Osborne, Maintenance Department reported to the Board that the boilers and air handlers are up and running with the usual bugs to work out. The sewer at the Junior High that was being repaired because of neglect and backups. Jennifer Haag at the bus barn has been very helpful helping us to get the snow trucks ready for winter. All of the plows and salt boxes are on and working. The skid steer would be delivered on the first of December.

Mrs. Jennifer Haag, Transportation Director, reported to the Board, that she just wanted to thank Chris Gibson and Nate Mattias for being so accommodating regarding the busses.

Mr. Steve Stein, Superintendent, reported to the Board that he has received one FOIA, from a Florida company, Smart Procure. Mr. Stein also reported that

the District will be getting a school resource officer, Mr. Dan Stankas. Mr. Stankas will begin in January 2019 as the District's school resource officer.

Mr. Stein reported that the Peotone High School Athletic Booster Club is requesting to become an independent 501(c) (3) charitable organization. The Booster Club feels that becoming a 501(c) (3) would help immensely in our fundraising as a charitable organization. Being independent and maintaining our own accounts, we will be able to accept credit cards and this will bolster our Booster Club sales.

Mr. Stein also reported that he has received a request from Roy Erickson to place a welcome to Peotone Junior High School carved stone at the junior high similar to the stone at the high school, but the stone will be place on the ground and not raised off the ground.

RE: ACTION REPORT – PHS Course Description Changes for 19-20

I have met with all of the curricular departments at PHS, along with administration and the guidance counselors, and the recommended course guide changes from those meetings are outlined below. All course proposals are contingent on student interest and enrollment numbers.

New Course Proposals:

Animal and Plant Science (Offered odd alternating years with Horticulture Science)

Grade: 10-12

2 Sem. 1 Credit

Prereg: Introduction to Agriculture Industry or teacher approval

(**This replaces the current Ag Science course)

This hands-on agricultural science course builds on basic skills and knowledge gained in the Introduction to the Agriculture Industry course. Major units of instruction include agricultural research, soil science, plant nutrition, agronomic crops, advanced plant science, biotechnology, animal reproduction, animal nutrition, basic anatomy & physiology, and meat science. Participation in FFA student organization activities and Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) projects are integral course components for leadership development, career exploration and reinforcement of academic concepts.

Advanced CTE Construction Applications

Grade: 12

2 Sem. 1 Credit

Prereq: Introduction to Career and Technical Education (formerly known as Introduction to Industrial Technology), Architecture and 3-D Design (formerly known as Introduction to Drafting), and Woodworking/Cabinet Making (formerly known as Woodworking) with a "C" higher or teacher approval. A grade of a "C" or higher in the first semester in order to continue to the second semester or teacher approval.

This class is designed to provide an advanced skill-set and knowledge in CTE and Construction. This includes safety, woodworking, frame carpentry, electricity, plumbing, drywall, stair construction, roof construction, and project management. This course will benefit students interested in careers such as: Finish Carpenter, Framing Carpenter Electrician, Plumber, Painter/Decorator.



Architecture and 3-D Design

Grade: 10-12

2 Sem. 1 Credit

Prereq: Introduction to Career and Technical Education (formerly known as Introduction to Industrial Technology) with a "C" or higher or teacher approval. Students who have prior completion of Introduction to Drafting are not eligible to take Architecture and 3-D Design.

(**This replaces all previous Drafting courses)

This course is designed to provide students the skills necessary to draft and design various projects both 2-D and 3-D using multiple Computer Aided Drafting (CAD) platforms. These include Google Sketch Up, Auto CAD, and software common in manufacturing. Students will design several architectural items including a house, apartment, and a sustainable dwelling. They will also learn how to create 3-D projects using a 3-D printer and a CNC engraver. This course will benefit students interested in careers such as: Draftsperson, CNC Operator, 3-D Technician, Engineer, Architect, and Project Manager.

Introduction to Career and Technical Education

Grade: 9-12

2 Sem. 1 Credit

Prereq: A grade of a "C" or higher in the first semester in order to continue to the second semester or teacher approval. Students who have prior completion of Introduction to Industrial Technology are not eligible to take Career and Technical Education.

(**This replaces the former Introduction to Industrial Technology course)

This class is designed to provide a small sampling of the different facets of Career Technical Education (CTE). This includes safety, woodworking, finishing, Computer Aided Drafting (CAD), 3-D printing, simple engineering, electricity, plumbing, and problem solving activities. Students must pass all safety tests (maximum three attempts on each test), and adhere to all safety procedures when using tools and equipment.

Woodworking/Cabinet Making


Grade: 11-12

2 Sem. 1 Credit

Prereq: Introduction to Career and Technical Education (formerly known as Introduction to Industrial Technology) and Architecture and 3-D Design (formerly known as Introduction to Drafting) with a "C" or higher or teacher approval. Students who have prior completion of Woodworking are not eligible to take Woodworking/Cabinet Making.

(** This replaces the former Woodworking course)

This course is a laboratory class designed to prepare students to be "Work ready" in the area of woodworking and cabinet making. Students will learn shop safety, advanced techniques, and cabinet making skills. This course will benefit students interested in careers such as: Cabinet Maker, Carpenter, CNC Operator, Shop Foreman, and Project Manager.



Algebra II Honors

Grade: 10-11

2 Sem. 1 Credit

Prereq: Geometry Honors with a "B" or higher during both semesters and/or teacher recommendation. (**This course is necessary to support students in last year's new Geometry Honors course)

This is an advanced course that will cover quadratic equations and functions, polynomials and polynomial functions, radical functions and rational exponents, rational functions, exponential functions and logarithmic functions. Students are required to have a model of the TI-84 calculator for this class. Graphing calculators are used to expand understanding. The instructor will provide grade appropriate standardized testing preparation. Completion of the summer review packet is required upon returning to school.

Advanced Placement World History: Modern

Grade: 10-12

1 Sem. 1/2 Credit

Prereq: English I Honors with a "B" or higher or concurrent enrollment in Pre-AP English II or teacher

Recommendation.

(**This is to meet newer criteria from AP/College Board regarding the content of World History curriculum)

AP World History: Modern is designed to be the equivalent of a two-semester introductory college or university world history course. In AP World History: Modern students investigate significant events, individuals, developments, and processes in multiple historical periods from approximately 1200 CE to the present. Students develop and use the same skills, practices, and methods employed by historians: analyzing primary and secondary sources; developing historical arguments; making historical comparisons; and utilizing reasoning about contextualization, causation, and continuity and change over time. The course provides five themes that students explore throughout the course in order to make connections among historical developments in different times and places: interaction between humans and the environment; development and interaction of cultures; state building, expansion, and conflict; creation, expansion, and interaction of economic systems; and development and transformation of social structures. Students completing the course have the opportunity to take the AP World History exam, administered by the College Board in the spring, which could qualify them to receive college credit for the course. The exam is not mandatory, but is highly recommended.

Functional Career Exploration

Grades: 9-12

2 Sem. 1 Credit

Prereq: IEP Placement

The Functional Career Exploration course helps students identify and evaluate personal goals, priorities, and interests with the goal of helping them in making informed decisions about their careers. This course exposes students to various sources of information on career and training options and may also assist them in developing job search and employability skills. This course is not NCAA approved nor will it be considered preparatory coursework for a 4-year university admission.



Foundations of Computers & Technology

Grades: 9-12

2 Sem. 1 Credit

Prereq: IEP Placement

This course is designed to develop digital citizens, create media literate students, and empower learners through the use of computers and technology. Students will use the Google Suite software including Google Drive, Google Docs, Google Sheets, Google Slides, Google Forms, and Google Drawings to prepare a variety of different documents and assignments. The impact of computers on society and ethical issues are also presented. In addition, students will be exposed to a variety of project-based learning activities to assess the impact of digital citizenship, media literacy & technology applications lessons. This course is not NCAA approved nor will it be considered preparatory coursework for a 4-year university admission.

PEOTONE HIGH SCHOOL EARLY GRADUATION

(AFTER THE 7th SEMESTER)

This application must be completed and submitted to the Guidance Office before the end of a student's 6th semester in high school. A student conference must take place with the school counselor by November of the student's senior year before the application can be sent to the Board of Education for its approval. The best interest of the student and his or her educational and vocational goals will be of prime concern in the consideration of any application.
